3. That the school shall appoint full time qualified and eligible staff for all classes of the school as per the present norms of the Department.
4. That the school shall equip the Science Labs as per the norms of the Department and suitable facilities for practical work shall be provided to the students.
5. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 1.0 books per student may be added.
6. That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately.
7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of Sec.10(1) of Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973.
8. That the enrolment in section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 sq.ft. per student for the available floor area of the classroom and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Education, Delhi in each class. Number of the existing sections should not exceed the number of existing classrooms of proper size in the school.

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Sir,

With ref. to your application on the subject cited above I am directed to convey the approval for the upgradation of the Middle School to Secondary level is granted (without aid) w.e.f. 1986-87 session subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act & Rules framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed.
3. That the school shall not appoint any new staff and will continue to operate with the same staff.
4. That the school shall equip the Science Lab, as per the norms of the department and suitable facilities for practical work shall be provided to the students. And a sum of Rs. 8000/- may be spent to further enrich the labs. Moreover, as and when the Xth class comes a further amount of Rs. 5000/- be spent on the purchase of ~~Balance~~ equipments for the labs.

6. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of the books per student may be added.
7. That the adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately.
8. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of Section 10(i) of the Delhi School Education Act & Rules 1973.

- (9) That the enrolment of section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 Sq.ft.per student for the available floor area of the class room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation, as per the norms of the Dte.of Education, Delhi in each class. Number of sections should not exceed the number of existing class rooms of proper size in the school.
- (10) That the school shall not run any un-recognised classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognised classes shall be run at one place at the above address only. Nursery class be removed from the premises of the school immediately.
- (11) That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.
- (12) That the scheme of management shall be got approved from the department immediately.
- (13) That the service contract between the management and the employees shall be executed immediately.
- (14) That all the facilities prescribed under rules 50 & 51 of the DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the student.
- (15) That the arrangement for good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to the teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificate may be obtained from the Local Body within a month.

Secondary level w.e.f. academic session 1988-89  
(Without aid) in Arts, Commerce and Science.

Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the approval of the Director of Education, Delhi for the upgradation of the existing secondary school to senior secondary level with effect from 1988-89 session subject to the fulfilment of the following terms and conditions:-

1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of Delhi School Education Act and Rules, framed thereunder as well as the instructions issued from time to time.
2. That the school shall admit the students without any discrimination of caste and creed.
3. That the school will meet the additional liability of senior secondary classes by appointing more staff as per the norms of the department, subject-wise PGTs shall be appointed and Govt. Nominee shall also be invited at the time of selection of teachers.
4. That the school shall establish and equip all the three separate Science Labs. as per the norms of the department/ CBSE and Rs.10,000/- in each science lab shall be spent by purchasing more equipment/material by march, 1988 and a list of the same shall be furnished to DDE (Science) for inspection. Separate Lab Asstt. for each shall also be appointed.

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5. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for students as well as teachers. Books as per the ratio of 10 books per students may be added.
6. That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately.
7. That the school shall strictly abide by the provisions of section 10 (i) of the Delhi School Education Act & Rules, 1973 and payment shall be made through crossed cheque. Service Agreement shall be executed with all the members of the staff, and recommendation of the IVth Pay Commission shall be implemented strictly and ~~area~~ if any be given immediately.
8. That the scheme of management of the school may be got approved from the department immediately, if approved, list of the members be submitted to DDE (Act).
9. That the enrolment of each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12sq.ft per student for the available floor area of the class-room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Education in each class. Number of sections should not exceed the number of existing class rooms of proper size in the school and each class-room, Science Labs. and library rooms may be fitted with proper electrical appliances.
10. That the enrolment in each class shall be increased sufficiently particularly in X and XI for the benefit of the students.
11. That the school shall not run unrecognised classes or any other activities within the school premises and all the recognised classes shall be run at one place at the above address only. Nursery classes be removed from the premises of the school immediately.
12. That the school shall dispense with the services of unqualified and over-aged staff, if any, immediately.
13. That all the facilities prescribed under Rule 50 and 51 of the Delhi School Education Rules, 1973 shall be made available to the students.

14. That the service contract between the management and the employee shall be executed immediately
15. That the arrangement for good drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to the teachers and sanitary facilities shall also be provided to the students adequately. Health Certificate may be obtained from the Local Body within a month.
16. That the management of the school shall create a Reserve Fund of Rs.15000/- (Rupees fifteen thousand) only in the name of Director of Education and the Manager of the school.
17. That the violation of any instructions/orders/conditions/rules and regulations of the department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school.
18. That the management of the school shall construct the school building within a period of three years.
